## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118– 36

At the end of subtitle H of title V, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 5 INSTRUCTION IN ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

5	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Defense, acting
6	through the Director of the Department of Defense Edu-

8	school operated by the Activity receives instruction in arti-
9	ficial intelligence and machine learning, including instruc-
10	tion in—
11	(1) the foundational concepts of artificial intel-
12	ligence and machine learning;
13	(2) definitions of artificial intelligence and ma-
14	chine learning;
15	(3) the responsible and ethical use of artificial
16	intelligence and machine learning applications; and

- 1 (4) such other topics relating to artificial intel-2 ligence and machine learning as the Secretary deter-3 mines appropriate.
- 4 (b) FORM OF INSTRUCTION.—The instruction re-
- 5 quired under subsection (a) may be incorporated into one
- 6 or more existing courses taught at high schools operated
- 7 by the Department of Defense Education Activity.
- 8 (c) APPLICABILITY.—The requirement to provide the
- 9 instruction described in subsection (a) shall apply begin-
- 10 ning with the first school year that begins after the date
- 11 of the enactment of this Act.
- 12 (d) Definitions.—In this section, the term "high
- 13 school" has the meaning given that term in section 8101
- 14 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965
- 15 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
