Page 393, strike lines 20 through 23 and insert the following: "in a fringe or corridor parking facility, including a park-and-ride facility, so long as such parking facility is not directly accessible from the Interstate System right-of-way and instead requires that a vehicle accessing the facility must first exit the Interstate System right-ofway onto another road before accessing the facility."

Page 394, after line 3, insert the following:

- "(3) STUDY.—The Secretary, in consultation
  with the Secretary of Energy and Commerce, shall
  conduct a study to determine—
- "(A) the variety of commercial services 4 5 such as the sale of food and beverages available 6 to motorists within one-half mile of Interstate 7 System exits on Interstates that have such com-8 mercial services available at rest areas on such 9 Interstates and that do not have such commercial services available at rest areas on such 10 11 Interstates;

22	would have on the desire for businesses located
