

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7148, AS REPORTED.**

**OFFERED BY MR. LARSON OF CONNECTICUT**

At the end of division B (before the short title), add the following:

1        SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. The salary of the Commissoner of Social  
2 Security is reduced to \$1 unless the Commissioner fur-  
3 nishes the House of Representatives, not later than 14  
4 days after the date of adoption of this Act, copies of any  
5 document, record, audio recording, memorandum, call log,  
6 correspondence (electronic or otherwise), audit trails and  
7 audit logs, written agreements, or other communication in  
8 his possession, or any portion of any document, record,  
9 audio recording, memorandum, call log, correspondence  
10 (electronic or otherwise), or other communication, that re-  
11 fers or relates to the following:

12                (1) The development of a cloud environment  
13 that hosts a copy of the Social Security Administra-  
14 tion's Numerical Identification System (hereafter re-  
15 ferred to as "NUMIDENT"), including risk assess-  
16 ments and security protocols.

17                (2) The purpose of creating a cloud environ-  
18 ment that hosts a copy of the NUMIDENT, includ-  
19 ing whether the copy will be used to—

1 (A) conduct Federal audits and investiga-  
2 tions;

3 (B) restrict or deny Social Security bene-  
4 fits, Medicare coverage, or any other benefits;

5 (C) develop a centralized database for the  
6 Federal Government that compiles citizens' per-  
7 sonal information across Federal agencies and  
8 departments;

9 (D) sell or make available information con-  
10 tained in the copy for private purchase; or

11 (E) train and enhance artificial intel-  
12 ligence.

13 (3) Access to, and usage of, NUMIDENT infor-  
14 mation hosted in such cloud environment by Edward  
15 Coristine, Aram Moghaddassi, John Solly, Michael  
16 Russo, or any other individual, including those act-  
17 ing for or on behalf of the Department of Govern-  
18 ment Efficiency (hereafter referred to as “DOGE”).

19 (4) Any agreements to share SSA data with  
20 outside entities signed by any individual acting for  
21 or on behalf of DOGE, and information on any sub-  
22 sequent data exchanges that occurred.

23 (5) The use of unauthorized third-party servers  
24 to share data.
