

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-

33

OFFERED BY MS. LEE OF NEVADA

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5___ . EXPANSION OF INDIVIDUAL LONGITUDINAL EX-**
2 **POSURE RECORD.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 996 of title 10, United
4 States Code, is amended—

5 (1) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
6 section (i); and

7 (2) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
8 lowing new subsections:

9 “(e) INCLUSION OF FAMILY MEMBER EXPOSURES.—
10 The Secretary may include in the Individual Longitudinal
11 Exposure Record of a member of the armed forces expo-
12 sures experienced by family members of such member dur-
13 ing an accompanied tour while such member is serving on
14 active duty, regardless of whether the location is in the
15 continental United States, outside the continental United
16 States, or a classified location.

17 “(f) INDIVIDUAL ACCESS TO DATA AND UPDATES OR
18 CORRECTIONS.—(1) The Secretary may provide to mem-

1 bers of the armed forces, veterans, designated family
2 members, and survivors password-protected access to view
3 data within the Individual Longitudinal Exposure Record
4 to which the individual is authorized to view.

5 “(2) An individual may request an update or correc-
6 tion to any data included in the Individual Longitudinal
7 Exposure Record that relates to the individual.

8 “(g) TOXIC EXPOSURE CAPABILITY.—The Secretary
9 may modify the Individual Longitudinal Exposure Record
10 to provide the capability to notify an individual of a poten-
11 tial toxic exposure of the individual in real time.

12 “(h) PRESERVATION OF RECORDS AFTER DEATH.—
13 The Secretary may modify the Individual Longitudinal
14 Exposure Record to preserve records of an individual after
15 the death of the individual for purposes of research, sur-
16 vivor benefits, and disease-cluster identification.”.

17 (b) FULL OPERATING CAPACITY.—Not later than
18 two years after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
19 Secretary of Defense shall ensure that the Individual Lon-
20 gitudinal Exposure Record maintained under section 996
21 of title 10, United States Code, is at full operating capac-
22 ity in accordance with the requirements and authorities
23 under such section, as amended by subsection (a).

24 (c) REPORT.—Not later than January 1, 2028, the
25 Secretary of Defense, in consultation with the Secretary

1 of Veterans Affairs, shall submit to the Committees on
2 Armed Services of the Senate and the House of Represent-
3 atives a report detailing—

4 (1) whether the Secretary intends to implement
5 subsections (e) through (h) of section 996 of title
6 10, United States Code, as added by subsection
7 (a)(2); and

8 (2) if the Secretary does not intend to imple-
9 ment any such subsection, the recommendations of
10 the Secretary with respect to the implementation of
11 such subsection.
