Amendment to Rules Comm. Print 118–36 Offered by Ms. Lee of Pennsylvania

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 17____. REPORT ON WOMEN'S RIGHTS IN SAUDI ARA 2 BIA.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State
5 shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees
6 a report regarding women's rights in Saudi Arabia that
7 includes information relating to the following:

- 8 (1) Systemic patterns of repression of women 9 and women's rights advocates,, including legal perse-10 cution, arrests, and capital sentencing, with analysis 11 of the roles of Saudi Government, police, or other 12 actors who are or have been involved, including 13 members of the House of Saud.
- 14 (2) Restrictions on women's rights advocates
 15 and advocacy, including legal prohibitions on rel16 evant political activity.
- 17 (3) An assessment of whether United States se18 curity assistance and training has been provided to
 19 Saudi units involved in political repression, and if so,

a description of the extent and duration of that as sistance.

3 (b) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
4 DEFINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate con5 gressional committees" means the Committee on Foreign
6 Affairs of the House of Representatives and the Com7 mittee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.
