(10) Set aside for art.—Not less than 1 2 percent of the amounts made available for any pro-3 gram under this division shall be used at the discre-4 tion of a State to supply grants for public art or 5 public arts programming, including any of the fol-6 lowing: (A) Outdoor events for the community 7 8 (such as concerts, street fairs, art fairs, com-9

munity arts events, performances, live music).

(B) Interviews and written stories that capture and document the history of the United States, through photographs, narratives, storytelling, murals, films, plays, and other media; and that illuminate narratives of first responders during the COVID-pandemic and under-told or erased narratives and histories of Black, indigenous, and other people of color, immigrants, people in rural communities, individuals with
