

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8
OFFERED BY MR. LEVIN OF CALIFORNIA

Add at the end of subtitle A of title XVII the following:

1 **SEC. 17 ____ . REQUIREMENT THAT CERTAIN FEDERAL**
2 **FIREARMS DEALERS PROVIDE SECURE FIRE-**
3 **ARMS STORAGE INFORMATION TO A PRO-**
4 **SPECTIVE FIREARM TRANSFEREE.**

5 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Beginning on the date that is
6 one year after the date of enactment of this Act, a licensed
7 dealer (as such term is defined in section 921(a)(11) of
8 title 18, United States Code) located on a military installa-
9 tion shall—

10 (1) provide such information about the secure
11 storage of firearms as the Secretary of Defense may
12 by regulation prescribe to any person (other than a
13 licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, licensed
14 dealer, or licensed collector) to whom the licensed
15 dealer sells or delivers a firearm; and

16 (2) post in a conspicuous place at each location
17 specified on the license of the licensed dealer, in no
18 smaller than twenty-six-point type, on a sign not less
19 than eight and one-half by eleven inches, and in bold

1 print, the following notice “Safety is paramount. Se-
2 cure storage of firearms significantly decreases the
3 risk of injury and death to children, household mem-
4 bers, and others. If you or a loved one is experi-
5 encing distress and/or depression, call the 988 Sui-
6 cide & Crisis Lifeline.”.

7 (b) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 180 days after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
9 Defense shall prescribe, by regulation, the information re-
10 quired to be provided under subsection (a)(1), which shall
11 include—

12 (1) best practices for the secure storage of fire-
13 arms to prevent unauthorized access to such fire-
14 arms, and available methods for such secure storage;

15 (2) suicide prevention and crisis service re-
16 sources; and

17 (3) such other information related to the safe
18 handling of firearms as the Secretary determines ap-
19 propriate.
