9	PFAS destruction technologies not requiring incineration.
10	The report shall include the following:
11	(1) A list of technologies that modify the char-
12	acteristics of the waste such that it is no longer clas-
13	sified as hazardous waste and can be disposed of
14	through more cost-effective mixed waste protocols.
15	(2) An identification of any such technologies
16	that have undergone, are undergoing, or will under-
17	go testing by the Environmental Security Tech-

- 4 (b) GUIDANCE.—Not later than one year after the
- 5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Under Secretary
- 6 of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment shall prescribe
- 7 guidance on best practices and preferred methods for de-
- 8 struction and disposal of PFAS wastes with an emphasis
- 9 on alternatives to incineration.
- 10 (c) Extension of Moratorium.—The Secretary of
- 11 Defense shall prohibit the incineration of covered mate-
- 12 rials under section 343 of the National Defense Authoriza-
- 13 tion Act for Fiscal Year 2022 (10 U.S.C. 2701 note) until
- 14 the date on which the Secretary prescribes the guidance
- 15 required under subsection (b).
