

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-54
OFFERED BY MR. LEVIN OF MICHIGAN

At the end of subtitle B of title XIII, add the following:

1 SEC. 13 . REPORT ON ARMS TRAFFICKING IN HAITI.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
3 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State,
4 in consultation with the Secretary of Commerce and the
5 Attorney General, shall submit to the appropriate congressional
6 committees a report on arms trafficking in Haiti.

7 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report shall
8 include the following:

9 (1) The number and category of United States-
10 origin weapons in Haiti, including those in possession
11 of the Haitian National Police or other state
12 authorities and diverted outside of their control and
13 the number of United States-origin weapons believed
14 to be illegally trafficked from the United States
15 since 1991.

16 (2) The major routes by which illegal arms are
17 trafficked into Haiti.

1 (3) The major Haitian seaports, airports, and
2 other border crossings where illegal arms are traf-
3 ficked.

4 (4) An accounting of the ways individuals evade
5 law enforcement and customs officials.

6 (5) A description of networks among Haitian
7 government officials, Haitian customs officials, and
8 gangs and others illegally involved in arms traf-
9 ficking.

10 (6) Whether any end-use agreements between
11 the United States and Haiti in the issuance of
12 United States-origin weapons have been violated.

13 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
14 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
15 sional committees” means—

16 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the
17 Committee on Foreign Affairs, and the Committee
18 on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives;
19 and

20 (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the
21 Committee on Foreign Relations, and the Committee
22 on the Judiciary of the Senate.
