

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-

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OFFERED BY MR. LEVIN OF MICHIGAN

Page 2, after line 15, insert the following new sub-
section:

1 (c) REVIEW.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 5 years after
3 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Adminis-
4 trator of the Environmental Protection Agency shall
5 submit to the appropriate congressional committees
6 a report containing a review of actions by the Envi-
7 ronmental Protection Agency to clean up contamina-
8 tion of the substances designated pursuant to sub-
9 section (a).

10 (2) MATTERS INCLUDED.— The report under
11 paragraph (1) shall include an assessment of clean-
12 up progress and effectiveness, including the fol-
13 lowing:

14 (A) The number of sites where the Envi-
15 ronmental Protection Agency has acted to re-
16 mediate contamination of the substances des-
17 ignated pursuant to subsection (a).

1 (B) Which types of chemicals relating to
2 such substances were present at each site and
3 the extent to which each site was contaminated.

4 (C) An analysis of discrepancies in cleanup
5 between Federal and non-Federal contamina-
6 tion sites.

7 (D) Any other elements the Administrator
8 may determine necessary.

9 (3) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-
10 TEES DEFINED.—In this subsection, the term “ap-
11 propriate congressional committees” means the fol-
12 lowing:

13 (A) The Committee on Energy and Com-
14 merce of the House of Representatives.

15 (B) The Committee on the Environment
16 and Public Works of the Senate.
