12	(1) implement the requirements of section 330
13	of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
14	Year 2020 (Public Law 116–92); and
15	(2) take into consideration the interim guidance
16	published by the Administrator of the Environ-
17	mental Protection Agency under section 7361 of the
18	National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
19	2020 (Public Law 116–92)

1	(b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the pub-
2	lication of the final regulations described in subsection (a),
3	and annually thereafter, the Secretary shall submit to the
4	Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency a
5	report on all incineration by the Department of Defense
6	of materials containing perfluoroalkyl substances,
7	polyfluoroalkyl substances, or aqueous film forming foam
8	during the year covered by the report, including—
9	(1) the total amount of such materials inciner-
10	ated;
11	(2) the temperature range at which such mate-
12	rials were incinerated; and
13	(3) the locations and facilities where such mate-
14	rials were incinerated.
