CHANGES IN AIRPORT SPONSORSHIP OR OPER-2 ATIONS. 3 Section 44706 of title 49, United States Code, is 4 amended-(1) by redesignating subsection (f) as sub-5 6 section (h); and 7 (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-8 lowing: 9 "(f) CHANGE OF AIRPORT SPONSORSHIP OR OPER-10 ATIONS.— 11 "(1) UNDISPUTED CHANGE OF AIRPORT SPON-12 SORSHIP OR OPERATIONS.—Except as provided for 13 in paragraph (2), for a proposed transfer of the 14 sponsorship or operations of an airport to a new 15 sponsor or operator, the Administrator shall issue an 16 airport operating certificate to a new sponsor or op-17 erator if $\mathbf{2}$

"(A) the holder of the airport operating
 certificate for such airport consents to the
 transfer of sponsorship or operations; and

4 "(B) the new sponsor or operator satisfies
5 all requirements for obtaining a certificate
6 under this section.

7 "(2) DISPUTED CHANGE OF AIRPORT SPONSOR-8 SHIP OR OPERATIONS.—For a proposed transfer of 9 the sponsorship or operations of an airport to a new 10 sponsor or operator for which the holder of the air-11 port operating certificate disputes such transfer, the 12 Administrator shall issue an airport operating cer-13 tificate to the new sponsor if the new sponsor or op-14 erator satisfies all requirements for obtaining a cer-15 tificate under this section and the dispute is resolved 16 by—

17 "(A) the issuance of a final, non-appeal18 able judicial decision requiring a change of
19 sponsorship or operations; or

20 "(B) the issuance of a consent letter be21 tween the holder of an airport operating certifi22 cate and a new sponsor or operator.

23 "(g) REIMBURSEMENT OF AIRPORT INVESTMENT.—
24 After a change in sponsorship or operations under sub25 section (f), the new airport sponsor or operator shall reim-

burse the previous holder of an airport operating certifi cate for investments made by such holder that have not
 been fully recouped as of the change in airport sponsorship
 or operations and such reimbursement shall be consistent
 with all policies and procedures of the Federal Aviation
 Administration.".
