

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-
19
OFFERED BY MR. TED LIEU OF CALIFORNIA**

Add at the end of subtitle G of title XII the following:

1 **SEC. ____. UNITED STATES STRATEGY FOR LIBYA.**

2 (a) **REPORT REQUIRED.**—Not later than 120 days
3 after the date of enactment of this Act, the President shall
4 submit to the appropriate congressional committees a re-
5 port that contains a strategy for Libya.

6 (b) **ELEMENTS.**—The report required by subsection
7 (a) shall include the following elements:

8 (1) An explanation of the strategy for Libya,
9 including a description of the ends, ways, and means
10 inherent to the strategy.

11 (2) An explanation of the legal authorities sup-
12 porting the strategy.

13 (3) A detailed description of U.S.
14 counterterrorism and security partnerships with Lib-
15 yan actors.

16 (4) A detailed description of Libyan security ac-
17 tors and an assessment of how those actors advance

1 or undermine stability in Libya and or U.S. strategic
2 interests in Libya.

3 (5) A detailed description of how Libyan secu-
4 rity actors support or obstruct civilian authorities
5 and U.N. led efforts towards a political settlement of
6 the conflict.

7 (6) A detailed description of the military activi-
8 ties of external actors in Libya, including Russia,
9 Egypt, France, Qatar, the Kingdom of Saudi Ara-
10 bia, Turkey, and the United Arab Emirates, includ-
11 ing assessments of whether those activities:

12 (A) have undermined progress towards sta-
13 bilization, including the United Nations-led ne-
14 gotiations;

15 (B) involve United States-origin equipment
16 and violate contractual conditions of acceptable
17 use of such equipment; or

18 (C) violate or seek to violate the United
19 Nations arms embargo on Libya imposed pur-
20 suant to United Nations Security Council Reso-
21 lution 1970 (2011).

22 (7) A plan to integrate the United States diplo-
23 matic, development, military, and intelligence re-
24 sources necessary to implement the strategy.

1 (8) A detailed description of the roles of the
2 United States Armed Forces in supporting the strat-
3 egy.

4 (9) Any other matters as the President con-
5 siders appropriate.

6 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
7 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
8 a classified annex.

9 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
10 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-
11 gressional committees” means—

12 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the
13 Committee on Foreign Relations, the Committee on
14 Appropriations, and the Select Committee on Intel-
15 ligence of the Senate; and

16 (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the
17 Committee on Foreign Affairs, the Committee on
18 Appropriations, and the Permanent Select Com-
19 mittee on Intelligence of the House of Representa-
20 tives.
