## **AMENDMENT TO**

## RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117–13 OFFERED BY MR. LIEU OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle F of title III, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 3 PILOT PROGRAM ON USE OF WORKING DOGS TO
2	DETECT EARLY STAGES OF DISEASES.
3	(a) PILOT PROGRAM.—Not later than 90 days after
4	the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
5	Defense shall commence a pilot program to determine the
6	effectiveness of using scent detection working dogs to de-
7	tect the early stages of diseases (including the coronavirus
8	disease 2019 (COVID-19)) and upon detection, to alert
9	the handler of the dog. In carrying out such program, the
10	Secretary shall consider—
11	(1) potential uses for such dogs in screening in-
12	dividuals seeking to access facilities under the juris-
13	diction of the Department of Defense or seeking to
14	access locations frequently used by the public and
15	relevant to public safety; and
16	(2) any other potential uses for such dogs relat-
17	ing to the detection of early stages of diseases, in-
18	cluding uses relating to the management and provi-

- 2 testing kits to Department of Defense personnel.
- 3 (b) REGULATIONS.—The Secretary shall prescribe
- 4 regulations concerning the scope and limitations of the
- 5 pilot program under subsection (a). Such regulations shall
- 6 include requirements to ensure that the pilot program is
- 7 scientifically rigorous.
- 8 (c) Duration.—The Secretary shall carry out the
- 9 pilot program under subsection (a) for a period of not
- 10 more than four years.
- 11 (d) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
- 12 on which the pilot program under subsection (a) termi-
- 13 nates, the Secretary shall submit to the Committees on
- 14 Armed Services of the House of Representatives and the
- 15 Senate a report on the outcomes of such pilot program.
