5 SEC. 7056. (a) GLOBAL DEMOCRACY PROMOTION.—

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, regulation, or  
7 policy, in determining eligibility for assistance authorized  
8 under part I of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22  
9 U.S.C. 2151 et seq.), foreign nongovernmental organiza-  
10 tions—

11 (1) shall not be ineligible for such assistance solely  
12 on the basis of health or medical services, including coun-  
13 seling and referral services, provided by such organizations  
14 with non-United States Government funds if such services  
15 do not violate the laws of the country in which they are

1 being provided and would not violate United States Fed-  
2 eral law if provided in the United States; and

3 (2) shall not be subject to requirements relating to  
4 the use of non-United States Government funds for advo-  
5 cacy and lobbying activities other than those that apply  
6 to United States nongovernmental organizations receiving  
7 assistance under part I of such Act.

8 (b) CONTRIBUTIONS TO UNITED NATIONS POPU-  
9 LATION FUND.—(1) Of the funds made available by this  
10 Act for fiscal year 2018, not less than may \$37,500,000  
11 shall be used to make a voluntary contribution to the  
12 United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) in order to  
13 provide assistance to expand access to and use of contra-  
14 ceptives in developing countries, furnish maternal and re-  
15 productive health care for victims of humanitarian crises,  
16 address the harmful practices of female genital mutilation  
17 and child, early, or forced marriage, and prevent obstetric  
18 fistula: *Provided*, That the UNFPA maintains such con-  
19 tribution in an account separate from other accounts of  
20 the UNFPA: *Provided further*, That such contribution  
21 may not be made available to perform abortions.

22 (2) Funds appropriated by this Act that are not made  
23 available for the UNFPA because of the operation of any  
24 provision of law shall be transferred to the “Global Health  
25 Programs” account and shall be made available for family

1 planning, maternal, and reproductive health activities,  
2 subject to the regular notification procedures of the Com-  
3 mittees on Appropriations.

4 (3) None of the funds made available to the UNFPA  
5 by this Act may be made available for any program,  
6 project, or activity in the People's Republic of China.

7 (c) REPORT ON UNFPA INVOLVEMENT IN CHINA.—

8 (1) Not later than 120 days after the date of the enact-  
9 ment of this Act, the Secretary of State shall submit to  
10 the Committees on Appropriations a report indicating the  
11 amount of funds budgeted by the UNFPA for programs,  
12 projects, or activities relating to the People's Republic of  
13 China for fiscal year 2018.

14 (2) The Secretary shall deduct, from any voluntary  
15 contribution made to the UNFPA after March 1, 2018,  
16 an amount equal to the amount of funds budgeted by the  
17 UNFPA for programs, projects, or activities relating to  
18 the People's Republic of China for such fiscal year.
