

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**

**19-33**

**OFFERED BY MRS. LUNA OF FLORIDA**

At the end of subtitle E of title X, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 10\_\_.** **PLAN FOR DOMAIN AWARENESS AT THE**  
2 **SOUTHERN LAND BORDER.**

3 (a) **DEFINITIONS.**—In this section:

4 (1) **COMMON OPERATING PICTURE.**—The term  
5 “common operating picture” means an integrated,  
6 interoperable, near-real-time geospatial and temporal  
7 display and repository of multi-source sensor, ana-  
8 lytic, and operational data and intelligence designed  
9 to improve situational awareness, deconfliction, and  
10 coordinated response among participating agencies.

11 (2) **DOMAIN AWARENESS.**—The term “domain  
12 awareness” means the aggregate understanding of  
13 activities, actors, and conditions across the air, land,  
14 maritime, cyber, and space domains relevant to bor-  
15 der security.

16 (3) **SOUTHERN LAND BORDER.**—The term  
17 “southern land border” means the land border of  
18 the United States adjacent to Mexico.

1 (b) PLAN REQUIRED.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days  
3 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-  
4 retary of Defense shall develop and submit to the  
5 congressional defense committees a plan for the De-  
6 partment of Defense to contribute to a common op-  
7 erating picture to improve domain awareness at the  
8 southern land border.

9 (2) COMMUNICATION.—Not later than 60 days  
10 after developing the plan required by paragraph (1),  
11 the Secretary of Defense shall transmit the plan to  
12 such interagency partners as the Secretary considers  
13 appropriate.

14 (3) ELEMENTS.—The plan required by para-  
15 graph (1) shall include the following:

16 (A) A description of the proposed architec-  
17 ture, data sources (including Department of  
18 Defense and non-Department of Defense sen-  
19 sors), technical standards for interoperability,  
20 and cybersecurity and data protection measures  
21 for the common operating picture described in  
22 such paragraph.

23 (B) A description of the procedures and  
24 authorities for data sharing.

1 (C) A concept of operations describing how  
2 a common operating picture would support  
3 operational coordination, deconfliction, and in-  
4 formation sharing among Federal, State, Trib-  
5 al, local, and authorized international partners.

6 (D) A phased implementation schedule  
7 with milestones and timelines for  
8 operationalizing the common operating picture  
9 at the southern land border, including bench-  
10 marks for capability deployment and full oper-  
11 ational capability.

12 (E) An identification of resource require-  
13 ments, estimated costs, and funding sources,  
14 and a plan for inclusion of requirements for the  
15 common operating picture in the annual budget  
16 justification materials of the Department of De-  
17 fense.

18 (F) Plans for training, sustainment, and  
19 technical support for users across participating  
20 agencies.

21 (G) Metrics and procedures for—  
22 (i) assessing effectiveness; and  
23 (ii) periodic review and continuous im-  
24 provement.

1           (4) FORM.—The plan required by paragraph  
2           (1) shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may  
3           contain a classified annex as necessary.
