At the end of subtitle B of title XVIII, add the following new section:

4	RORIST ORGANIZATIONS, AND OTHER ENTI-

6	(a) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
7	of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National In-
8	telligence shall submit to the appropriate congressional
9	committees a report containing an assessment of whether
10	the Ministry of Oil of Iraq or the State Oil Marketing Or-
11	ganization of Iraq (including any sub-entity thereof)—
12	(1) is under the control or influence of—
13	(A) any organization designated a foreign
14	terrorist organization by the Secretary of State
15	under section 219 of the Immigration and Na-
16	tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189), including Asa'ib
17	Ahl Al Haq, Kata'ib Hezbollah, and Harakat
18	al-Nujaba; or

(B) any other Iranian-backed militia
group, including the Badr Corps; or
(2) is providing funding to, or otherwise finan-
cially benefitting, any such designated foreign ter-
rorist organization, including Asa'ib Ahl Al Haq; or
(3) is or has been engaged in any activities with
any such designated foreign terrorist organization.
(b) Appropriate Congressional Committees
Defined.—In this section, the term "appropriate con-
gressional committees" means—
(1) the Committee on Armed Services, the
Committee on Foreign Affairs, and the Permanent
Select Committee on Intelligence of the House of
Representatives; and
(2) the Committee on Armed Services, the
Committee on Foreign Relations, and the Select
Committee on Intelligence of the Senate.
