## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117– 13

## OFFERED BY MR. LYNCH OF MASSACHUSETTS

At the end of subtitle D of title X of division A of the bill, add the following:

## 1 SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. PROHIBITION ON THE CONSOLIDATION OF 2 UNITED STATES COAST GUARD STATION 3 SCITUATE.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date of the en5 actment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security
6 may not take any action to consolidate, close, cease oper7 ations of, or reduce personnel at and use of United States
8 Coast Guard Station Scituate located in Scituate, Massa9 chusetts until—

10 (1) the Secretary of Homeland Security con-11 venes public meetings in all communities within the area of responsibility of United States Coast Guard 12 13 Station Scituate with regard to the proposed consoli-14 dation or closure and provides reasonable notice to 15 each congressional office representing any portion of 16 the area of responsibility of the schedule and loca-17 tion of such public meetings;

1 (2) the Inspector General of the Department of 2 Homeland Security conducts, and submits to the ap-3 propriate congressional committees, a comprehensive 4 audit to examine the impact of the consolidation or 5 closure proposal on the ability of the United States 6 Coast Guard to meet its Search and Rescue Mission 7 Response benchmark of two-hour total response time 8 for communities within the area of responsibility of 9 United States Coast Guard Station Scituate, wheth-10 er the consolidation or closure proposal will increase 11 average response time to communities within the 12 area of responsibility of United States Coast Guard Station Scituate, and whether the consolidation or 13 14 closure proposal will present a safety risk to resi-15 dents within the area of responsibility of United 16 States Coast Guard Scituate; and

17 (3) the Secretary of Homeland Security and the 18 Commandant of the Coast Guard both certify to the 19 appropriate Congressional committees that the con-20 solidation or closure proposal will not decrease the 21 average response time to communities within the 22 area of responsibility of United States Coast Guard 23 Station Scituate or present a safety risk to residents 24 within the area of responsibility of United States 25 Coast Guard Station Scituate.
