

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 116-57
OFFERED BY MR. LYNCH OF MASSACHUSETTS

At the end of title XII, add the following:

1 **Subtitle H—Afghanistan Security**
2 **and Reconstruction Trans-**
3 **parency Act**

4 **SEC. 1281. SHORT TITLE.**

5 This subtitle may be cited as the “Afghanistan Secu-
6 rity and Reconstruction Transparency Act”.

7 **SEC. 1282. PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF DATA PERTAINING TO**
8 **MEASURES OF PERFORMANCE OF THE AF-**
9 **GHAN NATIONAL DEFENSE AND SECURITY**
10 **FORCES.**

11 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 90 days after the
12 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
13 shall make publicly available all data pertaining to meas-
14 ures of performance of the Afghan National Defense and
15 Security Forces (hereafter in this section referred to as
16 “ANDSF”).

17 (b) **DATA TO BE INCLUDED.**—The data required to
18 be made publicly available by subsection (a) shall include
19 the following:

1 (1) The total quarterly ANDSF attrition rate
2 and quarterly attrition rates for ANDSF compo-
3 nents, including the Afghan National Army, the Af-
4 ghan National Police, the Afghan Air Force, and the
5 Afghan Local Police.

6 (2) The total number of ANDSF personnel
7 dropped from the rolls for the quarter and the num-
8 ber of personnel dropped from the rolls by ANDSF
9 component for the quarter.

10 (3) The total number of ANDSF personnel
11 trained to date, the number of new ANDSF per-
12 sonnel that entered training for the quarter, the
13 number of new ANDSF personnel that completed
14 training for the quarter, the total number of per-
15 sonnel trained by ANDSF component to date, the
16 number of new personnel by ANDSF component
17 that entered training for the quarter, and the num-
18 ber of new personnel by ANDSF component that
19 completed training for the quarter.

20 (4) The total number and percentage of unfilled
21 ANDSF positions and the number and percentage of
22 unfilled positions by ANDSF component.

23 (5) The percentage of ANDSF components as-
24 sessed at full authorized and assigned strength.

1 (6) Detailed Afghan Ministry of Defense, Min-
2 istry of Interior, and ANDSF performance assess-
3 ments.

4 (7) Information about the operational readiness
5 of Afghan National Army and Afghan National Po-
6 lice equipment.

7 (8) Afghanistan Special Mission Wing informa-
8 tion, including the number and type of airframes,
9 the number of pilots and aircrew, and the oper-
10 ational readiness (and associated benchmarks) of
11 airframes.

12 (9) Enemy-initiated attacks and effective
13 enemy-initiated attacks on the ANDSF.

14 **SEC. 1283. DISTRICT-LEVEL STABILITY ASSESSMENTS OF**
15 **AFGHAN GOVERNMENT AND INSURGENT**
16 **CONTROL AND INFLUENCE.**

17 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary of Defense shall re-
18 sume the production of district-level stability assessments
19 of Afghan government and insurgent control and influence
20 that were discontinued in 2018, to include district, popu-
21 lation, and territorial control data.

22 (b) **PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.**—The Secretary of De-
23 fense shall make publicly available the assessments and

- 1 all data pertaining to the assessments produced under
- 2 subsection (a).
