

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-13**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MALINOWSKI OF NEW JERSEY**

At the end of title LX of division E, add the following:

1 **SEC. 6013. REVIEW OF SANCTIONS WITH RESPECT TO RUS-**  
2 **SIAN KLEPTOCRATS AND HUMAN RIGHTS**  
3 **ABUSERS.**

4 (a) DETERMINATION WITH RESPECT TO IMPOSITION  
5 OF SANCTIONS.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
6 of the enactment of this Act, the President shall submit  
7 to the appropriate congressional committees a determina-  
8 tion, including a detailed justification, of whether any per-  
9 son listed in subsection (b) meets the criteria for the impo-  
10 sition of sanctions pursuant to section 1263(b) of the  
11 Global Magnitsky Human Rights Accountability Act (sub-  
12 title F of title XII of Public Law 114-328; 22 U.S.C.  
13 2656).
