At the end of subtitle C of title XIII, insert the following:

1 SEC. 13____. REPORT ON INCIDENTS OF ARBITRARY DETEN 2 TION, VIOLENCE, AND STATE-SANCTIONED 3 HARASSMENT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF 4 EGYPT AGAINST AMERICANS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the 6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State, in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, shall submit 7 to the appropriate congressional committees a report on 8 incidents of arbitrary detention, violence, and state-sanc-9 10 tioned harassment by the Government of Egypt against United States citizens, individuals in the United States, 11 12 and their family members who are not United States citi-13 zens, in both Egypt and in the United States.

14 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-15 quired by subsection (a) shall include the following:

16 (1) A detailed description of such incidents in17 the past three years.

(2) A determination of whether such incidents
 constitute a pattern of acts of intimidation or har assment; and

4 (3) Actions taken to meaningfully deter inci5 dents of intimidation or harassment against Ameri6 cans, individuals in the United States, and their
7 families by such government's security agencies.

8 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a) 9 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but the portions 10 of the report described in paragraphs (2) and (3) may con-11 tain a classified annex, so long as such annex is provided 12 separately from the unclassified report.

13 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
14 DEFINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate con15 gressional committees" means—

16 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
17 Committee on Armed Services of the House of Rep18 resentatives; and

19 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and20 the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate.
