

1 (2) A determination of whether such incidents
2 constitute a pattern of acts of intimidation or har-
3 assment; and

4 (3) Actions taken to meaningfully deter inci-
5 dents of intimidation or harassment against Ameri-
6 cans, individuals in the United States, and their
7 families by such government's security agencies.

8 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
9 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but the portions
10 of the report described in paragraphs (2) and (3) may con-
11 tain a classified annex, so long as such annex is provided
12 separately from the unclassified report.

13 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
14 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-
15 gressional committees” means—

16 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
17 Committee on Armed Services of the House of Rep-
18 resentatives; and

19 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
20 the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate.
