

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-13**  
**OFFERED BY MS. MALLIOTAKIS OF NEW YORK**

At the appropriate place in subtitle C of title XII,  
insert the following:

1 **SEC. 12 \_\_\_\_ . REPORT ON IRANIAN OPERATIONS ON UNITED**  
2 **STATES SOIL.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the  
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the President shall sub-  
5 mit to the appropriate congressional committees a report,  
6 including a strategy described in subsection (b)(4), that  
7 contains a description of malign operations by Iran con-  
8 ducted on United States soil.

9 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required by subsection  
10 (a) shall also include the following elements:

11 (1) A public list of all Iran-backed terrorist at-  
12 tacks, kidnapping, export violations, sanctions bust-  
13 ing activities, cyber-attacks, and money laundering  
14 operations on United States soil since 1979, includ-  
15 ing attempts at such activities that resulted in the  
16 filing of criminal charges.

17 (2) The actions of the United States in re-  
18 sponse to each activity or attempted activity listed  
19 pursuant to paragraph (1).

1           (3) A description of what persons, entities, and  
2 governments have aided Iran in such malign activi-  
3 ties on United States soil, including terrorist organi-  
4 zations.

5           (4) A strategy to prevent Iran from kidnapping  
6 American citizens and to deter Iran from conducting  
7 or planning operations such as the foiled plot to kid-  
8 nap Masih Alinejad.

9           (c) FORM.—The report and strategy required by sub-  
10 section (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form, but  
11 may include a classified annex. It shall also be publicly  
12 available on a website operated by the Federal Govern-  
13 ment.

14           (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES  
15 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-  
16 gressional committees” means—

17           (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
18 Committee on Foreign Relations, and the Committee  
19 on the Judiciary of the Senate; and

20           (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
21 Committee on Foreign Affairs, and the Committee  
22 on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives.
