

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-13
OFFERED BY MS. MALLIOTAKIS OF NEW YORK

At the appropriate place in subtitle C of title XII,
insert the following:

1 **SEC. 12 ____ . REPORT ON IRANIAN OPERATIONS ON UNITED**
2 **STATES SOIL.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the President, acting
5 through the Secretary of State and in coordination with
6 the Secretary of Defense, shall submit to the appropriate
7 congressional committees a report, including a strategy
8 described in subsection (b)(4), that contains a description
9 of malign operations by Iran conducted on United States
10 soil.

11 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required by subsection
12 (a) shall also include the following elements:

13 (1) A public list of all Iran-backed terrorist at-
14 tacks, kidnapping, export violations, sanctions bust-
15 ing activities, cyber-attacks, and money laundering
16 operations on United States soil since 1979.

17 (2) The actions and responses of the United
18 States in the aftermath of each such attempt,

1 whether successful or attempted and either thwarted
2 or failed.

3 (3) A description of what persons, entities, and
4 governments have aided Iran in such malign activi-
5 ties on United States soil.

6 (4) A strategy to prevent Iran from engaging in
7 the kidnapping of American citizens, to deter Iran
8 from conducting or planning operations such as the
9 foiled plot to kidnap of Masih Alinejad.

10 (c) FORM.—The report and strategy required by sub-
11 section (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form, but
12 may include a classified annex. It shall also be publicly
13 available on a website operated by the Federal Govern-
14 ment.

15 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIOANL COMMITTEES
16 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-
17 gressional committees” means—

18 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the
19 Committee on Foreign Relations, and the Committee
20 on the Judiciary of the Senate; and

21 (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the
22 Committee on Foreign Affairs, and the Committee
23 on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives.
