After section 2, insert the following new section:

1	SEC. 3. GRANT PROGRAM FOR NALOXONE RESCUE KITS.
2	The Public Health Service Act is amended by insert-
3	ing after section 514 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–7)
4	the following:
5	"SEC. 514A. GRANT PROGRAM FOR NALOXONE RESCUE
6	KITS.
7	"(a) Grant Program Establishment.—The Sec-
8	retary of Health and Human Services shall establish a
9	program to award grants to public libraries for one or both
10	of the following purposes:
11	"(1) To purchase naloxone rescue kits for use
12	in such public libraries.
13	"(2) To provide training to enable employees of
14	such public libraries to use naloxone rescue kits.
15	"(b) Eligibility.—
16	"(1) IN GENERAL.—To seek a grant under this
17	section, a public library shall submit an application
18	to the Secretary at such time, in such form, and

1	containing such information as the Secretary may
2	require.
3	"(2) Eligible public library.—To be eligi-
4	ble for a grant under this section, a public library—
5	"(A) shall certify that it owns, or will pur-
6	chase within 90 days of receipt of such grant,
7	a naloxone rescue kit;
8	"(B) must be maintained for, and open to,
9	the general public; and
10	"(C) must be in a county designated as a
11	high-intensity drug trafficking area pursuant to
12	section 707 of the Office of National Drug Con-
13	trol Policy Reauthorization Act of 1998 (21
14	U.S.C. 1706).
15	"(3) Limit on grants.—A library that re-
16	ceives a grant under this section shall not be eligible
17	to receive another grant under this section until one
18	year has elapsed from the date of receipt of such
19	grant.
20	"(c) Trained Employee Required.—
21	"(1) In general.—To be eligible to receive a
22	grant under this section, a public library shall certify
23	that—
24	"(A) on the date of receipt of such grant,
25	it will employ a full-time employee who has

1	been trained in the use of naloxone rescue kits;
2	or
3	"(B) if on the date of receipt of such grant
4	it will not employ a full-time employee who has
5	been trained in the use of naloxone rescue kits,
6	it will hire such an employee within 90 days of
7	the date of receipt of such grant.
8	"(2) Continuity in employment.—To be eli-
9	gible to receive a grant under this section, a public
10	library shall certify that for a continuous period of
11	one year following the date of receipt of such
12	grant—
13	"(A) in the case of a library that makes a
14	certification pursuant to paragraph (1)(A), it
15	shall not lack a full-time employee who has
16	been trained in the use of naloxone rescue kits
17	for a continuous period of longer than 30 days;
18	or
19	"(B) in the case of a library that makes a
20	certification pursuant to paragraph (1)(B), fol-
21	lowing the date upon which it first hires a full-
22	time employee who has been trained in the use
23	of naloxone rescue kits, it shall not lack such an
24	employee for a continuous period of longer than
25	30 days.

1	"(3) Full-time employee.—In this sub-
2	section, the term 'full-time employee' means, with
3	respect to any month, an employee who is employed
4	on average at least 30 hours of service per week.
5	"(d) Reporting Required.—As a condition on re-
6	ceipt of a grant under this section, a public library receiv-
7	ing such grant shall certify that it will report the use of
8	naloxone or a naloxone rescue kit on its property to the
9	Secretary on a quarterly basis for a period of one year
10	after the date of receipt of such grant.
11	"(e) Sunset.—The Secretary shall not award grants
12	under this section after the end of fiscal year 2022.".
