At th end of subtitle F of title X, insert the following:

1	SEC. 10 SENSE OF CONGRESS RELATING TO GALLIUM
2	SUPPLY CHAIN SECURITY.
3	It is the sense of Congress that—
4	(1) gallium is a strategic material essential to
5	United States national security and the development
6	of advanced technologies, including defense systems,
7	wireless communications, GPS navigation, high-per-
8	formance computing, electric vehicles, solar energy,
9	high-strength magnets, and medical applications
10	such as cancer treatment;
11	(2) the heavy dependence of the United States
12	on foreign sources of gallium, particularly the Peo-
13	ple's Republic of China, which accounts for approxi-
14	mately 98 percent of the global supply and has im-
15	posed an export ban to the United States, presents
16	a critical supply chain vulnerability that threatens
17	defense readiness and technological competitiveness;

1	(3) the development of a secure and resilient
2	North American supply chain for gallium is in the
3	national interest;
4	(4) to the maximum extent practicable, the De-
5	partment of Defense should support domestic ad-
6	vanced materials science research into gallium ex-
7	traction, recovery, and processing technologies;
8	(5) the United States should encourage cooper-
9	ative efforts involving United States companies and
10	allied partners, including Canada, to meet projected
11	domestic demand for gallium and reduce reliance on
12	foreign monopolies; and
13	(6) investment in and expansion of capabilities
14	based in the United States, in coordination with al-
15	lied nations, is necessary to ensure a secure supply
16	of gallium for defense and critical technology appli-
17	cations.
