

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. MASSIE OF KENTUCKY

After section 11612 of the bill, insert the following
new section:

1 SEC. 11613. INDUSTRIAL HEMP FARMING.

2 Section 102 of the Controlled Substances Act (21
3 U.S.C. 802) is amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (16)—

5 (A) by striking “(16) The” and inserting
6 “(16)(A) The”; and

7 (B) by adding at the end the following:

8 “(B) The term ‘marihuana’ does not include in-
9 dustrial hemp.”; and

10 (2) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(57) The term ‘industrial hemp’ means the
12 plant *Cannabis sativa* L. and any part or derivative
13 of such plant (including viable seeds), whether grow-
14 ing or not—

15 “(A) no part of which has a delta-9
16 tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of more
17 than 0.6 percent on a dry weight basis; and

18 “(B) the production, storage, distribution,
19 or use of which is lawful under the law of the

1 State or of the tribe having jurisdiction over the
2 area of Indian country (as defined in section
3 1151 of title 18, United States Code) where
4 such conduct occurs.”.
