At the end of subtitle B of title XVII add the following new section:

1	SEC PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS FOR FISA QUE-
2	RIES ON UNITED STATES PERSONS.
3	(a) Prohibition on Queries.—
4	(1) Prohibition.—Except as provided in para-
5	graph (2), none of the funds authorized to be appro-
6	priated or otherwise made available by this Act may
7	be used by an officer or employee of the United
8	States to query a collection of foreign intelligence in-
9	formation acquired under section 702 of the Foreign
10	Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 of (50 U.S.C.
11	1881a) using a United States person identifier.
12	(2) Exception.—Paragraph (1) shall not
13	apply to queries for foreign intelligence information
14	authorized under section 105, 304, 703, 704, or 705
15	of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978
16	(50 U.S.C. 1805, 1842, 1881b, 1881c, 1881d), or
17	title 18. United States Code.

1	(b) Prohibition on Requiring or Requesting
2	ALTERATIONS.—
3	(1) Prohibition.—Except as provided for in
4	paragraph (2), none of the funds authorized to be
5	appropriated or otherwise made available by this Act
6	may be used by the National Security Agency or the
7	Central Intelligence Agency to mandate or request
8	that a person (as defined in section 101 of the For-
9	eign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (50
10	U.S.C. 1801)) alter a product or service of the per-
11	son to permit the electronic surveillance (as defined
12	in such section 101) of any user of such product or
13	service for the National Security Agency or the Cen-
14	tral Intelligence Agency.
15	(2) Exception.—Paragraph (1) shall not
16	apply with respect to mandates or requests author-
17	ized under the Communications Assistance for Law
18	Enforcement Act (47 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).
