

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULE COMMITTEE PRINT 116-19**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MAST OF FLORIDA**

At the end of subtitle D of title VI, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 632. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN MORALE, WELFARE, AND**  
2 **RECREATION PRIVILEGES TO FOREIGN SERV-**  
3 **ICE OFFICERS ON MANDATORY HOME LEAVE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1065 of title 10, United  
5 States Code, as added by section 621 of the John S.  
6 McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal  
7 Year 2019 (Public Law 115-232), is amended—

8 (1) in the heading, by striking “**veterans**  
9 **and caregivers for veterans**” and inserting  
10 “**veterans, caregivers for veterans, and**  
11 **Foreign Service officers**”;

12 (2) by redesignating subsections (f) and (g) as  
13 subsections (g) and (h), respectively;

14 (3) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-  
15 lowing new subsection (f):

16 “(f) ELIGIBILITY OF FOREIGN SERVICE OFFICERS  
17 ON MANDATORY HOME LEAVE.—A Foreign Service offi-

1 cer on mandatory home leave may be permitted to use  
2 military lodging referred to in subsection (h).”; and

3 (4) in subsection (h), as redesignated by para-  
4 graph (2), by adding at the end the following new  
5 paragraphs:

6 “(5) The term ‘Foreign Service officer’ has the  
7 meaning given that term in section 103 of the For-  
8 eign Service Act of 1980 (22 U.S.C. 3903).

9 “(6) The term ‘mandatory home leave’ means  
10 leave under section 903 of the Foreign Service Act  
11 of 1980 (22 U.S.C. 4083).”.

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
13 this section shall take effect on January 1, 2020, as if  
14 originally incorporated in section 621 of Public Law 115–  
15 232.
