At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 17 TRANSMISSION OF INFORMATION RELEVANT
2	TO PERSONNEL SECURITY.
3	(a) In General.—The Secretary of State shall take
4	such steps as may be necessary to ensure, consistent with
5	subsection (b), that information relevant to the safety or
6	security of any covered individual that is transmitted to
7	the Secretary through the Dissent Channel, or through
8	any other or subsequent policy channel reserved for dis-
9	senting and alternative substantive foreign policy issues,
10	is promptly shared with—
11	(1) the Secretary of Defense;
12	(2) the heads of appropriate elements of the in-
13	telligence community (as such term is defined in sec-
14	tion 3 of the National Security Act of 1947 (50
15	U.S.C. 3003); and
16	(3) the head of any other relevant Federal de-
17	partment or agency.
18	(b) Protection of Sources.—In transmitting in-
19	formation in accordance with subsection (a) the Secretary

- 3 mains protected, and that only the information described
- 4 in such subsection is transmitted.
- 5 (c) COVERED INDIVIDUAL DEFINED.—In this sec-

- 7 (1) an individual employed at a United States
- 8 diplomatic or consular post; or
- 9 (2) a member of the United States Armed
- Forces.
