OFFERED BY MS. MCCLELLAN OF VIRGINIA

At the end of subtitle B of title III, insert the following:

**1 SEC. 2. STORMWATER DISCHARGE PERMITS FOR DEPART-
2 MENT OF DEFENSE FACILITIES.**

3 (a) REQUEST FOR REVISION.—Not later than one
4 year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
5 retary of Defense shall, with respect to each permit under
6 section 402(p) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act
7 (33 U.S.C. 1342(p)) that applies to a Department of De-
8 fense facility, request from the State that issued the per-
9 mit, or the Administrator of the Environmental Protection
10 Agency, as applicable, approval of a modification to such
11 permit, or a revision to an applicable stormwater manage-
12 ment plan, to require—

13 (1) monitoring of discharges of perfluoroalkyl
14 and polyfluoroalkyl substances not less frequently
15 than quarterly; and

16 (2) implementation of appropriate best manage-
17 ment practices or control technologies to reduce such

1 discharges consistent with the requirements of such
2 Act.

3 (b) FUNDING.—Of the funds authorized to be appro-
4 priated by this Act, or otherwise made available to the
5 Secretary in each fiscal year, for perfluoroalkyl and
6 polyfluoroalkyl substances remediation efforts, not less
7 than 1 percent shall be obligated or expended annually for
8 testing for such substances in stormwater runoff at De-
9 partment of Defense facilities.
