

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119–8**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MCCORMICK OF GEORGIA**

At the end of subtitle D of title XII, add the following:

1   **SEC. 12 \_\_\_\_ . REPORT ON STRATEGY FOR INCREASING MEM-**  
2                   **BERSHIP IN THE COMPREHENSIVE SECURITY**  
3                   **INTEGRATION AND PROSPERITY AGREE-**  
4                   **MENT.**

5           (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than July 1, 2026, the  
6 Secretary of Defense shall submit to the Committees on  
7 Armed Services of the Senate and the House of Represent-  
8 atives a report describing the strategic importance of the  
9 Comprehensive Security Integration and Prosperity  
10 Agreement and the benefits of its potential expansion.

11          (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required under sub-  
12 section (a) shall also include the following:

13           (1) An assessment of the strategic benefits of  
14 CSIPA to regional and global security.

15           (2) An assessment of CSIPA’s operational value  
16 to the Department of Defense and partners in the  
17 region following the Red Sea attacks.

1           (3) An assessment of how CSIPA leverages  
2       United States military assets such as the Fifth Fleet  
3       to address regional threats.

4           (4) Identification of potential modifications to  
5       the CSIPA framework that would support broader  
6       regional participation.

7           (5) An evaluation of the resource and capability  
8       requirements necessary to expand CSIPA member-  
9       ship.

10          (6) Recommendations for further collaboration  
11       between the United States Armed Forces and  
12       CSIPA members.

13       (c) DEFINITION OF COMPREHENSIVE SECURITY IN-  
14       TEGRATION AND PROSPERITY AGREEMENT.—In this sec-  
15       tion, the terms “Comprehensive Security Integration and  
16       Prosperity Agreement” and “CSIPA” refers to the cooper-  
17       ative agreement signed by the United States and the King-  
18       dom of Bahrain on September 13, 2023.
