

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-36
OFFERED BY MR. MCCORMICK OF GEORGIA

Add at the end of subtitle G of title X the following:

1 **SEC. 1085. EXTENSION OF UNITED STATES-MEXICO BORDER**
2 **METRICS REPORTING.**

3 Subsection (g) of section 1092 of the National De-
4 fense Authorization Act for 2017 (6 U.S.C. 223) is
5 amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1)(A), by inserting “and
7 make publicly available online, with classified infor-
8 mation omitted,” after “appropriate congressional
9 committees”;

10 (2) in paragraph (2) in the matter preceding
11 subparagraph (A), by inserting “and make publicly
12 available online, with classified information omit-
13 ted,” after “appropriate congressional committees”;
14 and

15 (3) by amending paragraph (3) to read as fol-
16 lows:

17 “(3) Not later than 60 days after the end of
18 each fiscal year through fiscal year 2036, the Sec-
19 retary shall submit to the appropriate congressional
20 committees and make publicly available online, with

1 classified information omitted, a ‘State of the Bor-
2 der’ report that—

3 “(A) provides trends for each metric under
4 this section for the last ten fiscal years, to the
5 greatest extent possible;

6 “(B) provides selected analysis into related
7 aspects of illegal flow rates, including undocu-
8 mented migrant flows and stock estimation
9 techniques;

10 “(C) provides selected analysis into related
11 aspects of legal flow rates;

12 “(D) provides policy recommendations on
13 how to strengthen border security and reduce
14 undocumented migrant flows; and

15 “(E) includes any other information that
16 the Secretary determines appropriate.”
