At the end of subtitle B of title III, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 3\_\_\_ . ANNUAL REPORT ON FUNDING AND STATUS OF**  
2 **INTERIM REMEDIAL ACTIONS OF DEPART-**  
3 **MENT OF DEFENSE RELATING TO PFAS.**

4 Chapter 160 of title 10, United States Code, is  
5 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

6 **“§ 2717. Annual report on perfluoroalkyl and**  
7 **polyfluoroalkyl substances**

8 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than one year after the  
9 date of the enactment of this section, and annually there-  
10 after, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the Com-  
11 mittees on Armed Services of the Senate and the House  
12 of Representatives a report on the funding and status of  
13 interim remedial actions of the Department of Defense re-  
14 lating to perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (in  
15 this section referred to as ‘PFAS’).

1       “(b) ELEMENTS.—Each report required by sub-  
2 section (a) shall include information regarding the fol-  
3 lowing:

4           “(1) The total funding budgeted and obligated,  
5 for the current fiscal year and for any prior fiscal  
6 year, per site at each installation, for interim reme-  
7 dial actions of the Department of Defense relating  
8 to PFAS.

9           “(2) In the case of each report after the initial  
10 report, the total funding budgeted, obligated and ex-  
11 pended, per site at each installation, on such actions  
12 since the previous report.

13           “(3) The general and operating status of in-  
14 terim remedial actions related to PFAS per site at  
15 each installation, including—

16           “(A) a list of all announced or selected in-  
17 terim remedial actions, and for each such ac-  
18 tion, the function and role of the action with re-  
19 spect to addressing PFAS at the installation;

20           “(B) for each action listed, a phase-specific  
21 status update including whether—

22           “(i) the design is pending, in  
23 progress, or completed;

24           “(ii) contracting is pending, in solici-  
25 tation, awarded, or delayed;

1                   “(iii) construction or execution has  
2                   begun, is in progress, completed, or de-  
3                   layed; or

4                   “(iv) the action is currently operating,  
5                   its duration, and any performance metrics  
6                   available;

7                   “(C) identification of actions that are one-  
8                   time in nature (such as soil removal and dis-  
9                   posal), and the status of each action;

10                  “(D) timelines for completion of each  
11                  phase, including original projected timelines  
12                  and any updates;

13                  “(E) for any phase delayed by more than  
14                  12 months beyond the original projection, a  
15                  site-specific explanation for the delay; and

16                  “(F) identification of any administrative,  
17                  regulatory, funding, or other barriers contrib-  
18                  uting to delays or budgetary effects, along with  
19                  the plan of the Secretary to address each such  
20                  barrier.”.
