

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-57
OFFERED BY MR. MCKINLEY OF WEST VIRGINIA

Add at the end of subtitle A of title XVII the following:

1 SEC. 1706. REPORT ON PIPELINE INFRASTRUCTURE.

2 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment
3 of this Act, the Secretary of Energy shall, in consultation
4 with the Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of Homeland
5 Security, the Federal Permitting Improvement Steering
6 Council, the Administrator of the Pipeline and Hazardous
7 Materials Safety Administration, the Director of the Of-
8 fice of Science and Technology Policy, and the Chairman
9 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, submit to
10 Congress a report that—

11 (1) identifies how developing domestic pipelines,
12 which transport oil, natural gas, or carbon dioxide,
13 promote a secure energy strategy for the United
14 States;

15 (2) evaluates the benefits of transporting oil,
16 natural gas, and carbon dioxide by various methods
17 of transportation, including pipelines;

1 (3) analyzes the vulnerabilities of pipelines to
2 accidents, operating errors, and malicious attacks;
3 and
4 (4) provides recommendations on how to im-
5 prove the Federal permitting and safety processes
6 for domestic pipeline development.
