Add at the end of subtitle A of title XVII the following:

SEC. 1706. REPORT ON PIPELINE INFRASTRUCTURE. 2 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment 3 of this Act, the Secretary of Energy shall, in consultation 4 with the Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of Homeland Security, the Federal Permitting Improvement Steering Council, the Administrator of the Pipeline and Hazardous 7 Materials Safety Administration, the Director of the Office of Science and Technology Policy, and the Chairman 8 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, submit to Congress a report that— 10 11 (1) identifies how developing domestic pipelines, 12 which transport oil, natural gas, or carbon dioxide, 13 promote a secure energy strategy for the United 14 States: 15 (2) evaluates the benefits of transporting oil, 16 natural gas, and carbon dioxide by various methods

of transportation, including pipelines;
