Add at the end of section 2002 the following:

(d) PROTECTING SENIORS' ACCESS TO MEDICARE.—
 In carrying out subsections (a) and (b), the committees
 named in such subsections should not submit changes in
 laws that would—

5 (1) reduce payment rates under title XVIII of
6 the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395 et seq.) for
7 items and services furnished by providers of services
8 (as defined in section 1861(u) of such Act (42
9 U.S.C. 1395x(u)) or suppliers (as defined in section
10 1861(d) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(d)); or

(2) increase Medicare beneficiary premiums
under such title, increase Medicare beneficiary costsharing (including deductibles, coinsurance, and copayments) under such title, or otherwise restrict
benefits under such title or modify criteria for eligibility for such benefits.

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
