AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–36 OFFERED BY MR. MEEKS OF NEW YORK

At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, add the following:

1 SEC. 17_. U.S.-AFRICA LEADERS SUMMIT AND RELATED 2 MATTERS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State shall, subject to the availability of funds, host one U.S.-Africa Leaders Summit at least once every two years as practicable,
or more frequently as appropriate, to strengthen ties and
promote cooperation with African leaders, as well as civil
society, business, diaspora, women, and youth leaders.

9 (b) U.S.-AFRICA CITY SUMMIT ("MINI SUM-MIT").—The Secretary of State should, not later than one 10 year after each summit hosted under subsection (a), or 11 12 more frequently as appropriate, host a U.S.-Africa City Summit ("Mini Summit") across cities in Africa or the 13 14 United States to promote subregional cooperation and serve as a catalyst in fostering engagement with represent-15 16 atives of government, civil society, business, academia, youth, culture and the arts, the African diaspora commu-17 18 nity, and underrepresented groups.

3	(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State is
4	authorized to establish within the Bureau for Afri-

6	ca Leaders Summit implementation unit responsible
7	for overseeing the implementation of commitments
8	made at summits described in this section.
9	(2) DUTIES.—The duties of the implementation
10	unit authorized by this subsection shall include—
11	(A) tracking and ensuring implementation
12	of commitments made during U.SAfrica Lead-
13	ers Summits;
14	(B) liaising with interagency partners and
15	the National Security Council regarding imple-
16	mentation of summit commitments;
