Strike subtitle A of title III and insert the following:

1 **Subtitle A—Food for Peace Act**

2 **SEC. 3101. ADDRESSING CHILD WASTING.**

3 Section 201 of the Food for Peace Act (7. U.S.C.
4 1721) is amended in paragraph (2) by adding “, and ad-
5 dress child wasting” after “combat malnutrition, espe-
6 cially in children and mothers”.

7 **SEC. 3102. FOOD AID QUALITY ASSURANCE.**

8 Section 202 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
9 1722) is amended—

10 (1) in subsection (d)—

11 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “or” at
12 the end;

13 (B) in paragraph (2), by striking the pe-
14 riod at the end and inserting “; or”; and

15 (C) by adding at the end the following new
16 paragraph:

17 “(3) a nongovernmental organization.”; and

18 (2) in subsection (h)(3), by striking “2023”
19 and inserting “2031”.

1 **SEC. 3103. MINIMUM LEVELS OF ASSISTANCE.**

2 Section 204 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
3 1724) is amended—

4 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by striking “2023” and
5 inserting “2031”; and

6 (2) in subsection (a)(2), by striking “2023” and
7 inserting “2031”.

8 **SEC. 3104. FOOD AID CONSULTATIVE GROUP.**

9 Section 205 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
10 1725) is amended in subsection (f), by striking “December
11 31, 2023” and inserting “December 31, 2031”.

12 **SEC. 3105. ISSUANCE OF REGULATIONS; OVERSIGHT, MONI-**
13 **TORING, AND EVALUATION.**

14 Section 207 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
15 1726a) is amended—

16 (1) in subsection (c)(1), by striking “the Agri-
17 culture Improvement Act of 2018” and inserting
18 “the Farm, Food, and National Security Act of
19 2026”; and

20 (2) in subsection (f)(4), by striking “2023”
21 each place it appears and inserting “2031”.

22 **SEC. 3106. INTERNATIONAL FOOD RELIEF PARTNERSHIP.**

23 Section 208(f) of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
24 1726b(f)) is amended to read as follows:

25 “(f) AVAILABILITY OF APPROPRIATIONS.—In addi-
26 tion to amounts otherwise made available to carry out this

1 section, of the funds made available in each fiscal year
2 under this title to the Administrator, not less than
3 \$15,000,000 shall be made available in each of fiscal years
4 2027 through 2031 to carry out this section, to remain
5 available until expended.”.

6 **SEC. 3107. SPECIALIZED NUTRITIOUS PRODUCTS.**

7 Section 402 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
8 1732) is amended in paragraph (2) by adding “and spe-
9 cialized nutritious products, including ready-to-use-thera-
10 peutic foods” after “high-value agricultural products”.

11 **SEC. 3108. PRE-POSITIONING OF AGRICULTURAL COMMOD-**
12 **ITIES AND ANNUAL REPORT REGARDING**
13 **FOOD AID PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.**

14 Section 407 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
15 1736a) is amended—

16 (1) in subsection (c)(4)(A), by striking “2023”
17 each place it appears and inserting “2031”; and

18 (2) in subsection (f)(2) by inserting after sub-
19 paragraph (D) the following new subparagraph:

20 “(E) An assessment of activities specifi-
21 cally targeting women and girls and the impact
22 of those activities in addressing the unique
23 needs of women and girls.”.

1 **SEC. 3109. DEADLINE FOR AGREEMENTS TO FINANCE**
2 **SALES OR TO PROVIDE OTHER ASSISTANCE.**

3 Section 408 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
4 1736b) is amended by striking “2023” and inserting
5 “2031”.

6 **SEC. 3110. MINIMUM LEVEL OF NONEMERGENCY FOOD AS-**
7 **SISTANCE.**

8 Section 412 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
9 1736f) is amended in subsection (e)(1), by striking
10 “2023” and inserting “2031”.

11 **SEC. 3111. TERMINATION DATE FOR MICRONUTRIENT FOR-**
12 **TIFICATION PROGRAMS.**

13 Section 415 of the Food for Peace Act (7
14 U.S.C.1736g-2) is amended in subsection (c), by striking
15 “2023” and inserting “2031”.

16 **SEC. 3112. JOHN OGWONSKI AND DOUG BEREUTER FARM-**
17 **ER-TO-FARMER PROGRAM.**

18 Section 501 of the Food for Peace Act (7 U.S.C.
19 1737) is amended by striking “2023” each place it ap-
20 pears and inserting “2031”.
