

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-**

**33**

**OFFERED BY MS. MEJIA OF NEW JERSEY**

At the end of subtitle C of title II, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 2\_\_.** **REPORT ON GUN-LAUNCHED ELECTRO-**  
2 **MAGNETIC OBSCURATION CAPABILITIES FOR**  
3 **NAVAL SYSTEMS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than March 1, 2027, the  
5 Secretary of the Navy, in coordination with the Chief of  
6 Naval Research and the Commander of the Naval Surface  
7 and Undersea Warfare Centers, shall submit to the Com-  
8 mittee on Armed Services of the House of Representatives  
9 a report on the feasibility and operational utility of inte-  
10 grating electromagnetic obscurant payloads into existing  
11 5-inch naval cargo rounds.

12 (b) **CONTENTS.**—The report under subsection (a)  
13 shall include the following:

14 (1) An assessment of the feasibility of inte-  
15 grating radiofrequency chaff or other electro-  
16 magnetic obscurant payloads into existing 5-inch  
17 naval cargo rounds and Mk 45 naval gun systems.

1           (2) An assessment of the operational utility of  
2           gun-launched electromagnetic obscuration capabili-  
3           ties for degrading adversary radar tracking, tar-  
4           geting, and sensor fusion in contested maritime envi-  
5           ronments.

6           (3) A description of ongoing or planned proto-  
7           typing, testing, or live-fire demonstration activities  
8           related to ship-launched electromagnetic counter-  
9           measure payload delivery.

10          (4) An assessment of integration considerations,  
11          including shipboard storage, handling, payload dis-  
12          persion, range, and compatibility with existing naval  
13          gun systems.

14          (5) An assessment of opportunities to leverage  
15          existing cargo munition technologies, infrastructure,  
16          or cross-service technical expertise relevant to elec-  
17          tromagnetic payload delivery.

18          (c) FORM.—The report required under subsection (a)  
19          shall be submitted in unclassified form but may include  
20          a classified annex.
