

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–46
OFFERED BY MR. MENENDEZ OF NEW JERSEY

Strike subsection (b) and insert the following:

1 (b) IDENTIFICATION OF CHINESE ENTITIES OF CON-
2 CERN.—Not later than 12 months after the date of the
3 enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security
4 shall identify and maintain a publicly available list of Chi-
5 nese entities of concern.

6 (c) RESTRICTIONS ON INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
7 EDUCATION.—Beginning with the first fiscal year that be-
8 gins after the date that is 12 months after the date of
9 the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Se-
10 curity shall ensure that an institution of higher education
11 (referred to in this subsection as an “institution”) which
12 has a monetary relationship with a Confucius Institute or
13 Chinese entity of concern included on the list under sub-
14 section (b) is ineligible to receive any funds from the De-
15 partment of Homeland Security, unless such institution
16 terminates such relationship. Upon such termination, such
17 institution shall be eligible to receive funds from the De-
18 partment.

19 (d) ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
20 rity shall provide outreach and, upon request, technical as-

1 sistance to institutions of higher education relating to
2 compliance with this section. In carrying out this sub-
3 section, the Secretary shall provide particular attention to
4 the following:

5 (1) Historically Black colleges and universities
6 (as such term is defined in part B of section 322(2)
7 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (22 U.S.C.
8 1061(2)).

9 (2) Hispanic serving institutions (as such term
10 is defined in section 502 of the Higher Education
11 Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1101a)).

12 (3) Tribal colleges and universities (as such
13 term is defined in section 316(b) of the Higher Edu-
14 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1059c(b)).

15 (4) Other minority serving institutions (as such
16 term is defined in section 371(a) of the Higher Edu-
17 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1067q(a))).

18 (e) WAIVER.—

19 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland
20 Security may waive, on a case-by-case basis, and for
21 a period of not more than one year, the application
22 of subsection (b) to an institution of higher edu-
23 cation if the Secretary determines such wavier is in
24 the national security interests of the United States.

1 (2) RENEWAL.—The Secretary of Homeland
2 Security may annually renew a waiver issued pursu-
3 ant to paragraph (1) if the Secretary determines
4 such waiver is in the national security interests of
5 the United States.

6 (3) NOTIFICATION.—If the Secretary of Home-
7 land Security issues or renews a waiver pursuant to
8 paragraph (1) or (2), respectively, not later than 30
9 days after such issuance or renewal, as the case may
10 be, the Secretary shall provide written notification to
11 the Committee on Homeland Security of the House
12 of Representatives and the Committee on Homeland
13 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate re-
14 garding such issuance or renewal, including a jus-
15 tification relating thereto.
