| 15 | ice, the surviving spouse of such member who acquires |
| 16 | ownership rights in a small business concern shall, for the |
| 17 | period described in paragraph (2), be treated as the sur- |
| 18 | viving spouse of a service-disabled veteran described in |

section 3(q)(2)(C)(i) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
 632(q)(2)(C)(i)).

3 "(2) The period referred to in paragraph (1) is the
4 period beginning on the date on which the member of the
5 Armed Forces dies and ending on the earliest of the fol6 lowing dates:

7 "(A) The date on which the surviving spouse of8 the member remarries.

9 "(B) The date on which the surviving spouse
10 relinquishes such ownership interest in the small
11 business concern.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (h) of section
8127 of such title, as added by subsection (a), shall take
effect on the date of the enactment of this Act and shall
apply with respect to the deaths of members of the Armed
Forces occurring on or after such date.
