

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8**  
**OFFERED BY MS. MENG OF NEW YORK**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

**1 SEC. 17\_\_\_\_. UPDATE OF INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY AS-**  
**2 SESSMENT ON GLOBAL WATER SECURITY.**

**3 (a) UPDATE REQUIRED.**—Not later than April 1,  
**4 2026**, the Director of National Intelligence, in coordina-  
**5 tion** with the Secretary of Defense and the heads of appro-  
**6 priate** elements of the intelligence community, shall submit  
**7 to** the appropriate congressional committees an updated  
**8 version** of the Intelligence Community Assessment titled  
**9 “Global Water Security”** numbered ICA 2012-08.

**10 (b) CONTENTS.**—The updated assessment under sub-  
**11 section (a)** shall include the following:

**12 (1)** All elements in the original assessment with  
**13 updated** data and analysis.

**14 (2)** Incorporation of relevant developments since  
**15 the** submission of the original assessment.

**16 (3)** An analysis of the efforts of foreign adver-  
**17 sarial** governments to gain access to, exert control  
**18 over**, or manipulate water resources, including the  
**19 governments’** rate of acquisition of or control over

1 groundwater or surface water beyond the sovereign  
2 territory of the governments, including transbound-  
3 ary waters, and geographical reach.

4 (4) An assessment of trends relating to conflict  
5 over water or attacks on water.

6 (5) Any additional matters the Director deter-  
7 mines appropriate or that the congressional intel-  
8 ligence committees may specify.

9 (c) FORM.—The updated assessment under sub-  
10 section (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form, but  
11 may include a classified annex.

12 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—  
13 In this section, the term “appropriate congressional com-  
14 mittees” means—

15 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
16 Committee on Foreign Affairs, and the Permanent  
17 Select Committee on Intelligence of the House of  
18 Representatives; and

19 (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
20 Committee on Foreign Relations, and the Select  
21 Committee on Intelligence of the Senate.
