TRAINING POLICIES REGARDING RACIAL, ETH-2 NIC, AND RELIGIOUS NONDISCRIMINATION. 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the 4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General 5 of the United States shall submit to Congress a report 6 describing-7 (1) each air carrier's training policy for its em-8 ployees and contractors regarding racial, ethnic, and 9 religious nondiscrimination; and 10 (2) how frequently an air carrier is required to 11 train new employees and contractors because of 12 turnover in positions that require such training. 13 (b) BEST PRACTICES.—After the date the report is 14 submitted under subsection (1), the Secretary of Transportation shall develop and disseminate to air carriers best 15 16 practices nevessary to improve the training policies described in subsection (a), based on the findings of the re-17 port and in consultation with— 18
