At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 17___ . UPDATE OF INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY-CO-**
2 **ORDINATED REPORT ON GLOBAL WATER SE-**
3 **CURITY.**

4 (a) **UPDATE REQUIRED.**—Not later than April 1,
5 2027, the Director of National Intelligence, in coordina-
6 tion with the Secretary of Defense and the heads of appro-
7 priate elements of the intelligence community, shall submit
8 to the appropriate committees an updated version of the
9 report titled “Global Water Security, Intelligence Commu-
10 nity Assessment, ICA 2012–08”.

11 (b) **CONTENTS.**—The updated report required under
12 subsection (a) shall include—

13 (1) all elements in the original report with up-
14 dated data and analysis;

15 (2) relevant developments since the submission
16 of the original report;

17 (3) an analysis of the efforts of foreign adver-
18 sarial governments to gain access to, exert control

1 over, or manipulate water resources, including the
2 rate of acquisition of, or control over, groundwater
3 or surface water by such government beyond the
4 sovereign territory, including transboundary waters,
5 and geographical reach of such governments;

6 (4) an assessment of trends related to conflict
7 over water or attacks on water; and

8 (5) any additional matters the Director deter-
9 mines appropriate or that the congressional intel-
10 ligence committees may specify.

11 (c) FORM.—The report required under this section
12 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
13 a classified annex.

14 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

15 (1) The term “appropriate congressional com-
16 mittees” means—

17 (A) the Committees on Armed Services of
18 the House of Representatives and Senate;

19 (B) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of
20 the House of Representatives;

21 (C) the Committee on Foreign Relations of
22 the Senate;

23 (D) the Permanent Select Committee on
24 Intelligence of the House of Representatives;

1 (E) the Select Committee on Intelligence
2 of the Senate; and

3 (F) the Committees on Appropriations of
4 the House of Representatives and Senate.

5 (2) The terms “congressional intelligence com-
6 mittees” and “intelligence community” have the
7 meaning given such term in section 3 of the Na-
8 tional Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003).
