6 (3) submit to the Committees on Armed Serv-7 ices of the Senate and the House of Representatives 8 a report setting forth an assessment of the feasi-9 bility and advisability of the establishment of a joint 10 Federal-State task force dedicated to the elimination 11 of unnecessary or duplicative occupational licensure 12 and credentialing requirements among the States, 13 including through the use of alternative, less restric-14 tive and burdensome forms of occupational regulation. 15
