

**AMENDMENT TO RULES**  
**COMMITTEE PRINT 115-70**  
**OFFERED BY MS. MENG OF NEW YORK**

Add at the end of title V the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . MECHANISMS TO FACILITATE THE OBTAINING**  
2 **BY MILITARY SPOUSES OF OCCUPATIONAL**  
3 **LICENSES OR CREDENTIALS IN OTHER**  
4 **STATES.**

5 Not later than March 1, 2020, the Secretary of De-  
6 fense shall—

7 (1) develop and maintain a joint Federal-State  
8 clearing house to process the occupational license  
9 and credential information of military spouses in  
10 order—

11 (A) to facilitate the matching of such in-  
12 formation with State occupational licensure and  
13 credentialing requirements; and

14 (B) to provide military spouses information  
15 on the actions required to obtain occupational  
16 licenses or credentials in other States;

17 (2) develop and maintain an Internet website  
18 that serves as a one-stop resource on occupational li-  
19 censes and credentials for military spouses that sets

1       forth license and credential requirements for com-  
2       mon occupations in the States and provides assist-  
3       ance and other resources for military spouses seek-  
4       ing to obtain occupational licenses or credentials in  
5       other States; and

6               (3) submit to the Committees on Armed Serv-  
7       ices of the Senate and the House of Representatives  
8       a report setting forth an assessment of the feasi-  
9       bility and advisability of the establishment of a joint  
10       Federal-State task force dedicated to the elimination  
11       of unnecessary or duplicative occupational licensure  
12       and credentialing requirements among the States,  
13       including through the use of alternative, less restric-  
14       tive and burdensome forms of occupational regula-  
15       tion.
