

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. MILLER OF OHIO

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII of division A,
add the following:

1 **SEC. 17__ . PROHIBITION ON IMET ASSISTANCE AND PRO-**
2 **GRAMS.**

3 Section 541 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961
4 (22 U.S.C. 2347) is amended by adding at the end the
5 following:

6 “(c) PROHIBITION.—

7 “(1) IN GENERAL.—A foreign government that
8 grants sanctuary to members of foreign terrorist or-
9 ganizations or Specially Designated Global Terror-
10 ists, as determined by the Secretary of State, shall
11 not be eligible for assistance or programs under this
12 section.

13 “(2) WAIVER.—The Secretary of State may
14 waive the prohibition under paragraph (1) with re-
15 spect to a foreign country if the Secretary deter-
16 mines it is in the national security interest of the
17 United States.

18 “(3) BRIEFING AND REPORT.—Upon request of
19 the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee

1 on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives
2 and the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Sen-
3 ate, the Secretary of State, not later than 60 days
4 after such request, shall—

5 “(A) provide a briefing (which may be in
6 classified format) to such committees regarding
7 the applicability of paragraph (1) with respect
8 to a foreign country that explains the decision
9 for such applicability; and

10 “(B) submit to such committees a report
11 (which shall be in unclassified form), but may
12 contain an classified annex.

13 “(4) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

14 “(A) the term ‘foreign terrorist organiza-
15 tion’ means an organization designated by the
16 Secretary of State pursuant to section 219 the
17 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
18 1189);

19 “(B) the term ‘grants sanctuary’, with re-
20 spect to a member of a foreign terrorist organi-
21 zation or Specially Designated Foreign Ter-
22 rorist, means a government that does not take
23 appropriate steps, taking into account its capa-
24 bilities to pursue, apprehend, and bring to jus-
25 tice an individual within its jurisdiction or to

1 obstruct the operations and remove the net-
2 works of the individual from such jurisdiction;
3 and

4 “(C) the term ‘Specially Designated Global
5 Terrorist’ means any person whose property
6 and interests in property are blocked pursuant
7 to section 594.201(a) of title 31, Code of Fed-
8 eral Regulations.”.
