6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall 7 carry out a pilot program under which the Secretary shall 8 award grants to vocational schools and community colleges 9 for the provision of training to eligible members of the 10 Armed Forces in skills necessary to support the produc-11 tion and manufacturing of semiconductors.

(b) ELIGIBILITY.—To be eligible to receive training
under the pilot program, a member of the Armed Forces
shall have an anticipated date of discharge or release from
active duty within 365 days of receiving such training.

16 (c) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Subject to the avail17 ability of appropriations made available in an Act enacted
18 after the date of the enactment of this Act, funds made

available in the CHIPS for America Fund pursuant to sec tion 102 of the CHIPS Act of 2022 (Public Law 117–
 167) after the date of the enactment of this Act may be
 used to carry out the pilot program required under this
 section.

6 (d) TERMINATION.—The authority to carry out a
7 pilot program under this section shall terminate on Sep8 tember 27, 2030.
