At the end of subtitle B of title XII, add the following new section:

11	increasing membership in the Comprehensive Secu-
12	rity Integration and Prosperity Agreement
13	("CSIPA"), done at Washington, D.C., on Sep-
14	tember 13, 2023.
15	(2) Elements.—The report required by para-
16	graph (1) shall also include a description of the fol-
17	lowing:
18	(A) The comprehensive strategic benefits
19	of the CSIPA being in place following the

3	(B) The reasons for which allied countries
4	in the region have been hesitant to join CSIPA.
5	(C) The long-term benefits of widened
6	membership in the CSIPA.
7	(D) How the framework of the CSIPA can

9	tegration, bolster mutual deterrence against ex-
10	ternal threats, and expand cooperation in the
11	fields of commerce, science, and technology.
12	(b) Strategy.—Not later than 180 days after the
13	submission of the report required by subsection (a), the
14	Secretary of Defense shall develop and submit to the ap-
15	propriate congressional committee on how to best engage
16	allied countries in the Middle East to join the CSIPA and
17	affirmative steps the Administration can take to increase
18	membership.
19	(c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
20	and the strategy required by subsection (b) shall be sub-
21	mitted in unclassified form, but may contain a classified
22	annex.
23	(d) Implementation Plan Required.—Not later
24	than 60 days after the date on which the Secretary devel-
25	ops the strategy required by subsection (b), the Secretary

shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees, or provide such committees a briefing on, a plan for imple-3 menting the strategy. 4 (e) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congressional committees" means the— 6 (1) Committee on Armed Services, Committee 7 on Foreign Affairs, and Permanent Select Com-8 mittee on Intelligence of the House of Representa-9 10 tives; and (2) Committee on Armed Services, Committee 11 on Foreign Relations, and Select Committee on In-12 13 telligence of the Senate.
